

Aberdeen World Opportunities Fund



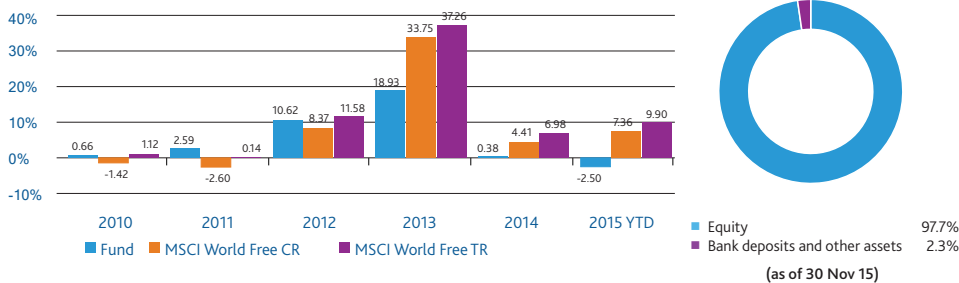
Investment policy

The Fund will mainly invest in units of a foreign fund, Aberdeen Global-World Equity Fund (Master Fund), at least 80% of its NAV in any accounting period. The rest will be invested in securities or other assets approved by the SEC as the fund manager deems appropriate for the benefits of unitholders.

Information ratio is a ratio of portfolio returns above the returns of a benchmark to the volatility of those returns. R-squared is a statistical measurement that determines the proportion of a fund's return that can be explained by variations in the market, as measured by a benchmark index.
